as we read the stones.


Many never reached the 'yards'. They are the best kept SECRETS

## IMPORTANT NOTES

Graves were recorded in the order in which the information was collected. There is an alphabetical listing, by surname, at the back of this book.

This work was done with as much total accuracy as is humanly possible. Perfection is never implied. The compilations are recordings of all visible and legible graves dated up to 1913, unless otherwise noted.

Following the index there may be a special section which lists those markers which are only partially legible and cannot be put in any order. Though it may appear, at first, to be meaningless, careful checking of surrounding graves coupled with the incomplete inscriptions may, be significant to some researchers. We do not have the heart to ignore any more salvageable information than has already been lost over time.

Those buried here whose names were never cut in stone, or whose markers are gone, are honored here as well.

Smiths Flat is 3 miles east of Placerville. Rich diggings were reported in 1849. A boulder of quartz with gold veins was found in March of 1854 and was valued at about \$6,000. Profits were increased after the Deep Channel Company introduced an improved cement crushing mill, the invention of a Mr. Woolsey.

A 10 stamp steam driven mill was built in 1864. The Toll House or Hook and Ladder Mine, a drift mine at Smiths Flat, was active before and during the 1890s and again from 1918 to 1932. This mine was said to have produced at least \$1,000,000 by 1898. The total production of the Smiths Flat placer mine was said to have been more than \$2,000,000."
