

## SCHOOL TOUR For Elementary Students

(This is information which may be used for background and information when leading classes of elementary students through the Hanford Carnegie Museum. There is more contained here than could possibly be used upon one occasion. You may emphasize the artifacts that interest you or which seem to be of interest to the group while omitting or playing down those things not of interest to you or to the group.)

STARTING IN FRONT OF THE FIRST WINDOW - LAKE EXHIBIT - TO THE RIGHT AS YOU COME IN.

Many years ago there was a very large lake in Kings County. At times it covered up to 760 square miles. Now we don't have a lake because of all the dams that have been built in the mountains that hold the water behind them until it is needed by the farmers for irrigation. Then it is sent down through the irrigation canals as it is needed by the farmers for irrigating, or watering their crops. Very little of the water comes down the rivers to the old lakebed.

The lake was named Tulare Lake. The word Tulare means "the place where the Tules, or wild grasses, grow." Thus, the lake and the town of Tulare were named for the wild grasses which grew around the lake. Because of the water and the grasses, many animals lived around the lake. Our valley was home to many animals. We had foxes, wolves, coyotes, antelope, elk, deer, wild horses and even grizzly bears. All of the animals you see in the museum -- with the exception of the moose hanging over that archway -- lived in Kings County at one time. Moose, of course, live much farther north where there is a lot of ice and snow. The other animals that you see lived in Kings County and were alive. After they died they were mounted by a process called taxidermy, so that we could show you the animals that lived in the valley.

Because of all the water and all the plants and animals that lived around the lake, as well as the fish and turtles in the lake and the ducks, geese and other shorebirds living around the lake, there was a good supply of food for people.

We know that, as long as 12,000 years ago, Indians hunted and lived around the lake shore. In these first two windows, along with the animals, we see some other things that were used by the Indians. At the far right in the first window you see something that looks like a brush. That's exactly what it was used for by the Indians. They would break of pieces of the root of the soaproot plant, bind each bunch together with a handle, and make very fine brushes.





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
